



Namibia's Big Game Wildlife Tour (north)

- ▶ Twyfelfontein - "fountain of doubt" – UNESCO World Heritage Site
- ▶ Damaraland/Kaokoland and the Desert Elephants & Rhinocerus
- ▶ The Etosha – Game viewing in the world famous National Game Park
- ▶ Game viewing in the Waterberg Plateau Park

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Namibia. Transfer from the airport is arranged on request. Participate in a City Tour, a Katutura Township Tour and do some shopping in Windhoek. Acclimatise and sleep over in Windhoek.

Day 2: After breakfast, depart from Windhoek for the north. Stop for lunch either in Omaruru. Visit the Arts and Craft Centres of the town, alternatively stop in Otjiwarongo and visit a crocodile farm. After lunch, travel on into Damaraland in north-eastern Namibia. Arrive at accommodation for the day near Twyfelfontein, "the fountain of doubt". Enjoy supper and sleep over.

Day 3: After breakfast depart for the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Twyfelfontein. Enjoy a guided walk with a local knowledgeable guide to see the fountain and the world's largest assembly of rock engravings. Afterwards, a short drive to see the *Welwitschia mirabilis* fossil plants, the Organ Pipes and the Burnt Mountain nearby. Then stop for lunch at your accommodation. After lunch a game drive or relax at the pool. Supper and sleep over.



Day 4: After breakfast depart for Damaraland/Kaokoveld. Stop for lunch at a lodge, a landmark in the area. After lunch, pay a visit to the 'Save the Rhino Trust' education centre for a briefing on the region and especially the rhinoceros of the area. Thereafter participate in some exciting game viewing in search of the desert elephants and with a bit of luck you can see wild lions and black rhinocerus. Proceed to accommodation for supper and a good nights rest.

Day 5: After breakfast depart for the Etosha National Park. On the way you will stop for lunch at a hotel in Outjo. After lunch you will travel on into the Etosha for some exciting game viewing. The chance to see lions and elephant are very good, and with a bit of luck, rhinos can also be spotted. Drive to the accommodation of the day, freshen up and go for supper and enjoy a good nights rest.

Day 6: After breakfast you will drive into the Etosha for some more exciting game-viewing. Observe the large herds of Springbok, Zebras and Oryx (Gemsbok) that inhabit the central Etosha. Stop for lunch at one of the waterholes and enjoy a lunch-pack. After lunch, travel on for more game viewing, ever in search of the big cats, lion, leopard and cheetah. Arrive at the accommodation of the day late afternoon. Supper and sleep over.

Day 7: After breakfast spend the morning in the Etosha for the final day of game-viewing. Stop for lunch at a lodge outside the park. After lunch spend time at the pool, walk an exciting trail or do some more searching for game. Return to the accommodation for supper and a good nights rest.

Day 8: After a hearty breakfast depart for the Waterberg Plateau Park. Stop for a viewing of Lake Otjikoto, the museum and one of the old copper mines and enjoy a light lunch in Tsumeb. After lunch you travel on to the Waterberg. Here there are some exciting walks and stunning sunset spots to be explored. Late afternoon you freshen up and go for supper and enjoy a good nights sleep.



Day 9: After breakfast a nature & game drive over the Waterberg Plateau in an official game-viewing vehicle. Here you can view amongst other game, the elusive buffalo. After the game-drive you return to your accommodation for lunch. After lunch relax at the pool or undertake a walk on one of the numerous walking trails for some exciting nature and game viewing. The chance to see the rare Klipspringer and other antelope are excellent. Return to accommodation for supper and a good nights rest.



Day 10: After breakfast you pack up and embark on the journey back to Windhoek. Check in at your accommodation for the evening and spend the afternoon shopping at the Namibia Craft Centre and in the Shopping Malls that offer you a wide variety of gifts to take back home. Return to the accommodation to get ready for an evening out at the internationally known restaurant and pub, Joe's Beerhouse, a must for every visitor. After supper return to your accommodation and a last nights rest. **Transfer to the airport is arranged on request.**

Reservation, Confirmation and Payment

The confirmation of a booking is seen as a final contract between the client and **ORUPUKA TRANSFERS & TOURS cc** furthermore referred to as **OT&T**. A booking is automatically confirmed and accepted with the final confirmation invoice. Together with the confirmation **OT&T** requests a non-refundable 25% deposit of the total price. The contract will be effective from receipt of deposit. Until then the correspondence is merely a quotation, subject to price changes and availability. Final payment is due to an account, not later than 8 weeks prior to arrival. On receipt of final payment the travel documents will be deposited for the clients attention at the car hire company, the transfer company or the first accommodation in Namibia, or if preferred faxed or posted directly to you at home, at an additional postage fee.

Cancellations

Any cancellation must be given in writing. Due to the varied and stringent cancellation policies of the different accommodation establishments the following applies:

41 days prior to the arrival date:	Deposit forfeited.
